“NEW MARKETING ARRANGEMENTS FOR QLD SUGAR

Legislation to implement an agreement between the Queensland Government and the State’s sugar industry to progress new marketing arrangements for Queensland-produced sugar was introduced into State Parliament today.

Primary Industries and Fisheries Minister Gordon Nuttall said to deliver on an agreement with CANEGROWERS and the Australian Sugar Milling Council last month, the Queensland Government was amending the Sugar Industry Act 1999 to remove the 90-year-old compulsory acquisition provisions.”
